Description:

This small three bay, four story high, white stucco building is located at the corner of St. Paul Place and E. Clay Streets. It has a central pedimented entrance flanked by two storefront windows. On the second and third floors there are three, nine over nine windows with subtle stone segmental arches above and stuccoed ledges. The fourth story has three smaller, eight over eight windows. There is no cornice or any decorative details on the building and the south elevation is two bays wide and brick.




This building dates back before 1885 and it is in good condition. The front facade has been totally covered over with white stucco and has no significant architectural details. The original brick appears on the south elevation and if the stucco on the front facade could be removed and the building restored, it would contribute to the historical character of the area.




