DESCRIPTION:

The two rowhouses are one of two remaining sections of two-story brick houses erected about 1885 on the east side of North Stockton Street between Laurens and Presstman Streets in west central Baltimore, Maryland in the area now called Sandtown-Winchester. The other section is described in B-1302. The main elevations face west. Each facade has two bays and two stories. No 1353 has 6/6 windows; those of 1351 are boarded. Gauged brick flat arches top the window and door openings. The continuous cornice features brick dentils and a slightly projecting wood corona. Wood steps are located at No. 1353 and concrete block steps at 1351.



Nos. 1351 and 1353 North Stockton Street are part of the remaining rowhouse streetscape of the eastern section of Sandtown-Winchester near the Lafayette Market. Both are contributing structures in an undefined late 19th century rowhouse district. (See also B-1302 for the other remaining houses on the east side of Stockton Street.)





