Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)  
 This is a three story row-house most likely built in the 1870's as were most of the other row houses in this part of the Harlem Park area. This dwelling is in an end of row position and the west façade (Fulton Street frontage) is configured with three window openings on the second and third floors and two windows and door openings on the first floor. The original windows were one over one wood windows, but have been severely modified or removed as a result of vandalism and renovations over the years. Three white marble steps lead to the front entrance door. There is a horizontal wood cornice, typical of the period, at the roof line and the "flat" roof itself slopes toward the east. The original brick front to the house has been covered fully with form-stone, concealing all original detail. There is a two-story rear addition to the main building that has been heavily modified over the years. The building has been vacant




