DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This corner row house is 3 1/2 stories high and 3 bays wide, made of stone and common bond brick with a metal cornice, and a flat roof.

The main entrance is rectangular with a transom and vestibule and inner door. The windows also are rectangular with stone lintels and sills.

There is a decorative brick course separating each story and columns of decorative brick separating the three bays in the front. Immediately above the third story are two flower design decorative reliefs.

Fenestration:

The English Basement has a store window composed of four pieces of plate glass.

Windows in stories one through three are all double hung.

In the first story they are seven-over-two, and set in flat arches. The second story windows are set in segmental arches; the upper sashes are divided into nine lights, with a circular division being inscribed in the central light. In the third story, the arrangement is seven-over-one, set in flat arches. The windows in the half story above the third story are one piece casement windows; in the center bay these are paired, but separated by a mullion.


