DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This mid block 3 story, 3 bay rowhouse is surfaced in painted running bond brick.</p> <p>One of the 2 basement windows has been converted into a door, and a flight of steps is recessed into the pavement parallel to the facade. A stone watertable forms the lintels for the window and door. A stone stoop with scrolled corner blocks appears to the left.</p> <p>The double entrance doors, which both have a single large pane of glass, are capped by a rectangular transom, which in turn is crowned by a stone entablature. There is a vestibule. All the windows are one-over-one with stone sills and lintels formed by band courses. Another band course appears at $3/4$ of ^{the} height of the extremely tall parlor windows. The second floor sills feature corbeled brick consoles.</p> <p>A row of brick laid diagonally to form a toothed shadow pattern appears over the third floor band course. A similar course of bricks also appears as one of the elements in the corbeled brick cornice. This house once had an attic floor with a mansard (similar to 16 E. Biddle Street) but it has been removed and replaced by a tiny pent roof behind which is the actual flat roof.</p>






