DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This apartment house, 4 stories high, 6 bays wide, is situated number 3 from the corner, and the brick construction is laid in Flemish bond. All the windows are rectangular, 6 over 6 lights with flat arched brick lintels and marble sills. The entrance is in the center. Four steps lead to a portico with a pedimented roof supported by Ionic columns. Pilasters flank the doorway which is rectangular in shape, but there is a brick arch over a fanlight above the door.

Curved iron balcony railings mark the <sup>4 outer</sup> windows on the 2nd story, while at the top of the building a frieze of triglyphs and metopes decorates the area below the classic cornice.. The roof is ~~shaded~~ flat.

At the sidewalk level steps lead down on either side of the main entrance into areaways that open into small stores. One is a card shop, the other was a barber shop, but is now closed and the glass front has been cemented over.

The two central bays are slightly recessed and the 1st floor brick work (running bond) has several indented courses which suggest rustication.


