DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick house which is located near the south end of the block is 3½ stories high and 3 bays wide, and was built around 1873. It is laid in running bond. The doorway, framed in marble, ~~has a basket handle arch~~ and ~~is~~ a transom. Five steps lead to a stoop before a vestibule and inner door. All the windows except the attic are rectangular, one over one lights with flat-arched brick lintels and marble sills. The slate-shingled Mansard roof, rising above a projecting cornice which is supported by brackets, is pierced by two fullparched dormer windows, the surrounds of which appear to be wood. *The center portion of the roof is in low relief and is edged with curbing creating a pavillion effect.*

Attached to the first floor windows are shallow iron-railed balconies, undoubtedly later additions. Above the third story windows are recessed brick features which are purely decorative, adding interest to an otherwise plain area.

The dormer windows are double hung with 2/2 lights. Two basement windows puncture the marble ashlar base which supports a projecting marble belt course. The first floor windows above are the tallest on the facade, rising to the height of the entrance opening, which is filled with double wooden doors with panels of bevelled glass.


