DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Again of rock cut random ashlar granite, this midblock 3½ story, 3 bay rowhouse is of the same materials as 1208 N. Calvert, but the composition of the facade is very different; more symmetrical.

The stoop with parallel stairs, and entrance vestibule are similar, as are the first floor windows. The basement has a one-over-one window (no grille) and a low entrance (a single door with wood side panels). The brick band course continues across the facade above the first floor.

The second and third floor one-over-one windows are set within 3 round headed blind arches surfaced in brick. The granite pilasters each have a single block of stone at the springing point of the arches. The second floor windows are rectangular with splayed brick lintels and the ones on the third floor are fully arched.

The molded cornice is slightly recessed from those of the 2 flanking houses. There is a wide 3 windowed shed dormer. The edge of the dormer roof swells gently above the wood fan over the center window. The upper sash of each of these double hung windows has many small square panes, the lower a single pane. The roof is of slate.




