DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This grand three story, five bay townhouse has a symmetrically arranged facade composed of brick with stone detail. A generous stoop with low stone rails and squat newells divides the base, which is punctuated by four window openings, filled with iron grillwork. Flanking the windows at this level are heavy brackets supporting balconies with low rails of carved stone rings resting between posts. Twin terraces paved in a checkerboard of white and black stone and surrounded by short, cast-iron floral spikes, flank the stoop and complete the ground level design.

The first floor facade is marked with a round-arched entrance with drip-molding surround. It is flanked by a pair of Ionic pilasters which support a flat entablature. Double Walnut doors with glass-filled upper panels beneath a large semi-circular transom, fill the entranceway. The first floor windows are like all of those bordering the central bay: rectangular, having stone frames, sills, and lintels and having double-hung windows with 1/1 lights. Those on the first floor are taller, however, in scale with the entrance, and are equipped with round-headed window-caps carved with a floral design. All others have pedimental window-caps.

The central bay of the second floor rises from the doorway entablature below to hold a double window, which is double-hung with 1/1 lights. A horizontally divided tripartite window-cap with projecting central slab and short pedimental crown extends vertically at either end in short, shallow pilasters to visually support the sill of the third floor window. It is also a double window, double-hung with 1/1 light, and carries a long pedimental window cap. String courses picked out in stone above the floor level make three horizontal divisions on the facade, and a massive wooden cornice mounted with six heavy brackets crowns the roof. An unusual freestanding rounded tympanum carved in a floral motif rises from the cornice above the central bay.





