DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The facade of this two bay, semi-attached, Flemish bond brick, gabled townhouse is accented by stone lintels and sills. A single stone step leads to the doorway which is surmounted by a transom and flanked by a recessed columned portico. Decorative stone moldings ornament the marble bay. Double hung windows with one over one lights on the second and third floors continue the simple lines of the house which is crowned by a Spanish tile gabled roof.


