DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is similiar to the rowhouses located at 1021, 1017, 1015, 1013, and 1011 St. Paul Street. All are two bays wide, three and a half stories high, have mansard roofs, two dormer windows and date from the mid to late 1800's. The brick exteriors (laid in running bond) are accented by projecting wooden sills. The other significant architectural element of the house, the doorway, is rectangular surmounted by a fan light transom which is encased in a compound arched door frame with double-cone wooden molding and prominent keystone. Stone steps and a wrought iron railing lead to the doorway.</p> <p>Symmetrical fenestration, proportionally scaled from first to third floors, punctuates the facade. The second and third story windows are double hung and have two over two lights. The window on the first floor is a double window with wrought iron balcony. Dormer windows, each topped by a pointed pediment, are placed in the mansard roof, and pilasters are applied on either side of each dormer window. A wooden cornice with brackets adorns the roofline.</p>


