DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

A dentiled cornice with 2 deep, scrolled end brackets adorns the edge of the flat roof on this 3 story building located in mid-block. Of painted brick, it has a first floor shop and shares a sally port with 857 N. Howard Street (left side of building).

There is a wide wood door with glass panel to the right, and a slight protruding shopwindow supported by brackets to the left. This window has 2 very narrow panes at right angles to the large front pane and is backed by 3 loaded glas windows. Two brackets support a signboard above the shop.

The sills of the two 2nd floor windows are immediatly over the sign. These double hung windows are of mane small rectangular panes of leaded glass and have splayed brick lintels.

There is a tripartite window of the third floor consisting of 3 vertical panels with a narrow concrete sill and lintel. The center, panel is a single pane of glas and each side panel consists of 2 horizontal panes, one top and one bottom, with 2 vertical panes between them.
