This 2½ story with sloped roof has been surfaced in form - stone. Located in midblock, it shares a salleyport (to the left) with 863 N. Howard Street.

The shop window, to the right, extends slightly from the wall and is a single pane. The entrance is a glass and metal door. Above, the shop cornice has been covered with formstone. There are 2 one-over-one double hung windows on the second floor and a 6-over-6 window in the peaked roof dormer.





