DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 3 story, 3 bay building is surfaced in white aluminum clapboards. It has a flat roof and is located in mid-block.

On the first floor is a central single pane shop window over a low brick base, flanked by 2 entrances. The one on the left (to the upper floors) is a solid wood door and the store entrance (to the right has a pair of glass and metal doors topped by a transom). There is a signboard over the window and doors.

There is a handsome wrought iron balcony on the 2nd floor, and three tall 4-over-4 windows. On the third floor the windows are 2-over-2 double hung. There is a 3 paneled cornice with 4 deep brackets and dentiles.





