DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The 1st floor of this painted brick, 3 story, 3 bay house has been converted into a shopfront. Though located within the block, the left sidewall fronts on a very narrow alley.

The shop window, located to the left, extends slightly from the facade. It has 3 vertical panels of glass on the street and two forming a diagonal wall for the recessed entrance. The panes are set over a base faced with tile. There are two entrance doors, the one to the shop very deeply recessed, the louvered door at the extreme right slightly indented. The right door has a rectangular transom. There is a wide fascia over the shop front with an applied sign board which features a "Colonial" split pediment.

The proportionately scaled one-over-one windows all have brick sills and splayed brick lintels.




