DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 3 story flat roofed building of running bond brick has a shepfront similar to those at 895 and 893 N. Howard St. located next to the corner building, it has 2 bays on the upper floors.

The 2nd and 3rd floor 2-over-2 double hung windows have stone sills and segmentally arched brick lintels. The dentiled and bracketed cornice is set beneath a low parapet. Its two end brackets are deeper and more elaborate than the 7 center ones. Square ended tie bars arranged in three vertical rows of varying length punctuate the facade.




