DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Built of common bond brick, this 2 story flat roofed house is attached on the right to a similar building. On the left is a parking lot.

Both the door (to the right) and 6-over-6 double hung window have segmental brick arches. The window is protected by an iron grill and the entrance is a flush door.

A shallow oriel on the second floor is composed by 3 6-over-6 windows. It is set immediately below a heavy lintel. There is a roof drain, but no cornice and a shared chimney to the right.
