DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Though the left side wall (partly surfaced in concrete) faces a parking lot, this 2 bay, 3 story house originally was enclosed on both sides. It is now one of a pair (of common bond brickwork) which shares a sally port and a double chimney. The six panel door and transom, to the left are approached by 2 stone stairs. A low brick planter to the left of the stairs contains evergreen shrubby.

The windows are proportionately scaled from 1st to third floors and have wood sills and blinds. The 6-over-6 windows on the first and second floors and the entrance have splayed brick lintels. The small one-over-one attic windows are set just below 2 corbeled courses of brick which form a minimal cornice at the edge of the slightly sloped roof.
