DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This three story, three bay brick building with a flat roof is located in mid-block. It shares a double staircase (4 steps on each side) of running bond brick with 825 N. Howard Street. The first floor of this building has been remodeled into a shopfront, the materials and style of which is continuous across the next 3 buildings. (825, 827, 829).

This shopfront is of vertically grooved aluminum and glass. On this building, the entrance door and transom and a side panel their right, recessed to the left of the facade. The shop window consists of two panels of plate glass over a horizontal portion of the aluminum. Above is a band of more aluminum.

The three 1-over-1 double hung windows on both the 2nd and 3rd floors have gauged brick lintels and stone sills. The cornice with its attached string course is divided into 3 panels by 4 deep brackets. There are 3 small brackets and a central ornamentally pierced wood ventilator grille in each panel.



Sanborn Map, 1914 (revised 1953)




Baltimore City iMap image, 2006
