DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Though this 3½ story painted brick building, located in midblock, has a shopfront of vertically grooved aluminum like its 3 neighbors to the south, it is very different above.

The entrance is approached by a brick stoop with 4 stairs to the side and an ornamental iron rail. The recessed entrance is to the left; single pane shopwindow to the right. A folding canvas awning obscures part of the upper metal fascia.

There are two stone silled, stone linteled 6-over-6 double hung windows on the second floor and 2 pairs of single pane casement eye brow windows in the attic. The attic level is treated as a panel of low relief brick which steps just short of the edges of the facade. It is further ornamented by 2 relief courses at its lower edge, the upper one forming a window sill, and a row of dentils and a relief course forming a brick cornice.
