DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 2 story, rust brick building with flat roof is located in mid-block. The first floor is a shopfront.

There is an entrance recess to the left, one angled side of the shop window forming its paneled doors with transoms, one on the area wall of the transom, the other immediately to the right on part of the angled wall. Each panel of the shop window consists of a single pane of glass, with transoms above; the front of the window protrudes from the facade.

The second floor tripartite window consists of 25 pane windows with horizontal mullions flanking a single pane window. There is a brick sill and a band of brick framing the sides and top with mitered corners. Under the metal cornice with end brackets is a deep band of corbeled brick brackets.


