DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Three stories in height, this 2 bay building is of painted running bond brickwork. The shopfront is surfaced in light green aluminium clapboards.

There is an angled floor recess to the left with two paneled doors and their transoms, one on the side recess wall. The shop windows consists of two panes of plate glass.

The windows on the upper 2 floors are one over one with brick sills. These windows are evident by much smaller than the original ones, splayed brick lintels can be seen above but not touching them, and the second floor windows have new brick work under them as well. This wall is in poor condition, despite much patching there are many cracks and a definite slope towards the right.

The elaborate cornice has two cleop end brackets with several smaller ones in between. There is also an attached dentiled string course and several moldings.
