DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The first floor of this two bay, 3 story building with flat roof, has been altered into a shop front. The brick facade has been painted.

The entrance is to the left and is flanked by two pilasters and topped by a simple entablature. Five marble stairs ascend to the wood door with large glass panel, which is capped by a transom. There is a grilled basement window with stone sill to the right. Over it is the shop window in 3 panels, with 3 transoms. The narrow side panels are angled so that their outside edges are recessed forming an embedded bay window. This window is framed by an ornamented band and topped by an entablature decorated with sways.

The one-over-one double hung windows on the upper floors have stone sills and splayed brick lintels. The dentiled cornice is divided into 2 panels by 3 deep, scrolled brackets.
