DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 5 bay, 4 story building is located in mid block and has a flat roof. It is built of running bond brick and has stone trim. All windows except those in the basement are double hung with stone sills.

The basement is of rock faced stone and is capped by a protruding band course. There are two grilled basement windows under each bay except for the central one which is occupied by 5 stone stairs which ascend to the recessed entry porch.

The entrance recessed is flanked by 2 pilasters, each ornamented with a block featuring a circle motif, which support a dentiled entablature with scrolled end brackets. A large sign with brass letters is fit in under the entablature. The double entry doors and two side lights each feature an upper pane of glass and a lower wood panel. Two narrow top lights frame the central transom which has 3 panes. A band course in two layers, the same depth as the entablature.






