 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Another 2½ story eyebrow window house similar, though reversed, to 832 Tyson Street, but with original window sizes and wood sills.

The eyebrow windows and transom are each a single sheet of glass rather than 3 panes. The stoop of this house, and the 4 houses to its right, consists of 3 brick stairs which lead directly up to the 6 paneled door. Two scrolled, Victorian, wrought iron railings have been attached to the stairs. The 6-over-6 windows have shutters, each constructed of 3 vertical boards with slits between them held together by 2 horizontal cross pieces. The coal door is decorated with 2 human figures.






