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This 2½ story painted brick house is again similar to 832 Tyson Street, but reversed. The windows retain their wood sills and original size. The transom over the 6 panel door has 4 panes rather than 3 and there are 3 brick steps ascending directly to the door. The coal door has been replaced by a 4 paned window with shutters. The 3 6-over-6 windows also have these vertical board shutters, again much too narrow. The chimney and shared sally port are to the right.




