DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 2½ story, 2 bay house of running bond brickwork ^{is of a type} typical to Baltimore during the 1830's and 1840's. The entrance to the left, is reached by 4 brick stairs (of recent work) parallel to the facade. The 6 panel door and its 3 fluted pilasters, using one for the top piece as well, capped by a trianangular pediment. This door surround is very obviously not old. There is a cast iron cold door decorated with an eagle to the right of the steps. This house shares an arched sally port with 834 Tyson Street.

The three six-over-six windows have brick sills, splayed lintels and two narrow shutters. These windows were probably heightened when the house was renovated. Less taller than the 1st floor windows, those on the 2nd floor have iron window attached to their shutters.

The wall surface of the attic is in low relief to suggest an entablature. There are two wood silld eyebrow windows each with 3 panes of glass. A simple wood cornice adorns the roofline and a shared chimney to the right. Eight thirty two and eight thiry four Tyson Street, both have a drain-pipe enclosed with wood and pierced metal sheeting. These drain pipes, each on one side of the sally port, are a prominent feature of the facades of these two houses.







Sanborn Map, 1914 (revised 1953)




Baltimore City iMap image, 2006
