DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building is a three story, three bay rowhouse located near the corner of Calvert and Madison Streets (its right side faces a corner parking lot). The foundation is stone, the surface is running-bond brick, and the roof is flat with a bracketed wooden cornice. The ground floor has been altered for commercial purposes: A shingled awning spans the entire width, and the two right bays contain a tripartite fixed-pane picture window over a stone sill. A double entrance opens in the left bay ; double gates in front of a double door are approached by four marble steps with wrought iron rails. Stone pilasters frame the outer gates. A stone belt course runs directly under the sill from the doorway to the right; below, a stone foundation is punctuated by two cellar windows in the two right bays.

Each second floor bay contains a double hung window with 1/1 light, with stone sill and flat stone lintel capped by a flat window hood. The third floor windows are similar, but have no hoods.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>Aside from the warehouses and other commercial structures which occupy much of this block, there are older examples of architecture here which merit attention.</p> <p>The Ebenezer Baptist Church at 220 East Madison Street provides a turn of the century (1899) exemplar of a small church designed in the Gothic Revival Style looking specifically to late Medieval English parish churches for inspiration. 831 North Calvert Street provides another facet of late nineteenth century architectural eclecticism with its Beaux Arts inspired fire Engine House (c. 1910). The rowhouses beginning at 805 North Calvert, all in very good exterior condition, provide relatively unaltered examples of Civil War era urban dwelling design (1866).</p> <p>The block is chiefly significant for its architectural diversity. It provides a half century of various styles, and reflects certain aspects of orthodox thought insofar as what certain types of buildings should look like; hence Beaux-Arts is reserved for a public structure, Gothic Revival appears, typically, in a church design, and a sort of diluted Italianate flavor enhances this block's examples of Baltimore's unique stylistic contributions to nineteenth century rowhouse architecture.</p>





