DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This masonry structure is comprised of three sections. The lateral sections are one bay wide and two stories high, and the center section is three bays wide, and two and a half storied high.

Center Section: Four steps lead to a double doorway, above which is a transom with six lights. Flat-arched, stepped moulding occurs above the door and on the door's left, but not on the right. This same motif is carried into the flanking windows, which are single hung with twelve lights, flat stone lintels, and brick sills. Immediately above and below the windows are three rectangular recesses in the masonry. The recesses below the windows are larger than those above.

In the second story, a string course forms the sills for the windows above it. This string runs the entire length of the facade and around the sides of the building. The central window is single hung with twenty-four lights. The lateral windows are single hung with twenty lights. All windows have flat-arched lintels. A belt course appears above the second story windows at the level of the roof-line of the lateral sections of the building. Above each second story window, at the level of the belt course, is a small rectangular window, which appears to have grating instead of glass. Above these is a parapet rising above the lateral sections.

Lateral Sections: The first story of the facade contains a blind bay. On the sides of these sections of the building, there is one single hung fifteen light window with a flat-arched, straight bond brickwork lintel.

In the second story, there is one single hung window with twelve lights on both the facade and sides of the building. The string course between the first and second floors again serves as a sill for these windows. Their lintels are flat-arched, made of straight bond brickwork. A Pilaster--flat, of brick--terminates the lateral sections' sides.
