**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a two bay wide, two story high building with brick foundation and building walls. The roof is flat, and although there is no cornice the parapet wall carries two curves, making it modestly ornamental. The first story facade is symmetrically punctuated by two sets of flat plate glass double doors surmounting stone stoops and separated by a modest expanse of wall. For the most part the brick wall has been covered over with aluminum siding. Three housings for movie poster advertisements are between and to either side of the doors. A half hexagonal marquee projects from the facade between the first and second stories.

The second story brick facade is punctuated by two large openings that have been boarded over. These openings have brick lintels and brick moldings on either side.





Baltimore City iMap image, 2006
