DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

525 N. Howard Street is a three bay wide, three story high building with a flat roof and stone foundation wall. The first story facade is primarily wood and glass with a flat wooden door and stone stoop in a recessed entrance to the left of the facade. The remainder of the facade is given over to a two light large flat plate glass window with a stone sill and wood lintel. These two elements, the door and window, are surmounted by a six light transom that spans the entire facade. The transom is flat. Directly above the transom the facade bears a cornice with dentals that visually divides the first and second story facades.

The second and third story facades are each punctuated by a continuous large wood panel centered in the facades and embellished with decorative moldings. This panel houses three windows in either facade. Two windows in the second story facade are flat single light casements with flat transoms. The third window was more than likely the same kind but is now boarded over. It is also surmounted by a flat transom. All these windows have wooden sills and lintels. A cornice visually divides the wood panel into its second and third story facade components. The three windows in the third story facade component of the wood panel are flat single hung windows all surmounted by flat transoms. These windows also have wood sills and lintels. A cornice supported by brackets and a shallow parapet wall surmount the building's facade.





Baltimore City iMap image, 2006
