DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Though the right side wall of this 3½ story house faces an alley it is similar to 511 Cathedral Street. The most obvious difference is that the street facade has been resurfaced in form stone. The side wall on the alley has several windows including 2 in the attic. A row of dentils embellishes the central molding of the door entablature, but is missing from the cornice. The porch rail over the floor slab is entirely of wrought iron in a pattern of bands of intersecting ellipses, curves and diamonds. A peaked dormer with a pair of 3 panel casements lights the attic, while 2 chimneys are visible along the right side wall.
