 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 3½ story Greek Revival house of painted brick, with a peaked roof, is located in mid-block.

The recess^{ed} entrance with transom which is framed by two ~~wide~~^{broad} flat pilasters and a deep entablature is located to the left. The pilasters are molded at the top to form ~~a~~ capitals and the entablature has a simple cornice, and a plain molding running midway across its surface. There is a marble stoop with five stairs approaching it running parallel to the facade of the building. A squat Tuscan column supports the porch floor slab at its left outside corner. The bottom stair is curved on its outside edge and the wrought iron rail conforms to the scroll. The hand rail is supported by plain vertical uprights over the stairs, but by an intricate pattern of cast iron circles and elongated ovals, trimmed with brass knobs over the floor slab. There are two cellar windows with splayed brick lintels. The 6-over-6 double hung windows are symmetrically arranged in 3 bays, proportionately scaled from 1st to third floors. They have stone sills and gauged flat arches of brick. There is a narrow dentiled cornice at the roof line. Two skylights are visible on the roof and a chimney is to the right.
