



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 3½ story painted brick house is similar to 511 Cathedral Street. The most important difference is a large 2nd floor oriel having 3 sides. It has 4 6-over-6 double hung windows (two in the center) a dentiled cornice and 3 rectangular panels under the windows. The side panels both have a wreath motif, the central panel a festoon. A continuous festoon ornaments the band over the windows, just under the cornice. The first floor windows are 1-over-1 and those in the basement are protected by wrought iron grills, similar to part of the railing on 511 Cathedral. The stoop slab here has a pattern of bands of intersecting ellipses and diamonds. The door transom is of leaded glass and the central molding of the entablature has a row of tiny dentils. There are two dormers, both peaked, the one in the center has a pair of 8 paned casements, while a very small one to the left has a single square casement. A chimney is visible to the right.



