DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 3½ story Greek Revival house feature one English basement and unusual fenestration on the second and third floors. It is one of the three unaltered house of an original group of six. The walls are of flemish bond brickwork.

A stoned band course just above the entrance door and two windows defined the lower ceiling height of the ground level. The front door to the left is flanked by 4 paned sidelights, each with a tower paneled section. The two slightly sqat six-over-six double hung windows have stone sills and wooden blinds. There is a central stone framed cellar entrance flush with the sidewalk and a cellar window sank into a well at the right.

The second and third floors both have a central tripartite window with stone sill and lintel. Each window consists of a central 6-over-6 window flanked by narrow 2-over-2 windows. The second floor windows are taller than those on the third floor which are set just below the roof line. The sidelights have wood blinds.

A single row of bricks in relief forms a minimal cornice below the sloped roof. There is a central peaked dormer with 6-over-6 windows and a chimney to the right.



