DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

A shopfront occupies the first floor of the four story flat roofed building. The left sidewall faces a parking lot and has been resurfaced with common bond brick. Two doors, a six panel one to the right and a glass panel one with transom flank the central shop window. There is a stone framed area with iron railing in front of the window and a hood over the left door which obtrudes part of the wide fascia between the first floor and the second floor window sills.

Nine six-over-six double hung windows proportionately scaled from second to fourth floors, in three bays, punctuate the running bond brick of the upper floors. Vertical header lintels and wood sills enframe the windows. There is no cornice.
