DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This 3 story, yellow brick building is at the oblique corner of Hamilton Street and St. Paul Place. It has 5 bays on the Hamilton Street side and 3 on St. Paul Place. All windows except those in the basement are one-over-one double hung with stone sills, and splayed brick lintels each with a keystone. The central doorway is slightly recessed and flanked by pilasters. The door cornice is topped by a concave hood. Three stairs ascend to the off center stock Colonial door and its one sidelight to the right which are surmounted by a rectangular transom. Above the roof cornice is a low parapet. There are two large billboards on the roof. The basement windows increase in size with the slope of the hill, the two on St. Paul Place being the largest. There is also a door between these windows at the sidewalk level.




