DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two-story corner building in excellent condition built in 1953. The front portion of the building is of concrete with a four foot high marble facing flush to the building. The building has no cornice adornment and has a flat roof. The entrance of the building has a three-door entrance with flat transom and vestibule. The vestibule is two stories high with recessed entrance lights in the ceiling. There are no windows on the first floor but there are recessed showcases on each side of building front at height where windows would normally be located. The second floor has casement windows with eight lights in each window placed over first floor entrance. There are three sets, one over each door. There is the illusion of two story pillars between each door. The front of the building faces on Howard Street.

Mulberry Side of Building

The building is divided into two segments on this side. The front portion of the building carries through the pattern of the front - concrete with marble facing up from the ground for four feet. Windows on the first floor are ten-light casement windows. The windows on the second portion of the building are six-light and four-light. There is one door on the side (222 Mulberry Street). The second segment of the building is common bond brick. The second floor is similar to first; the windows are similar but are eight-light casement windows.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This building is part of a block that had its main construction period in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The character of this block is such that there is a potential for historic development even considering the massive amount of alteration in facades and the deterioration of the exterior of the remaining parts of the buildings. There are new structures and vacant areas now used as parking lots which suggest that the remaining buildings with significant architectural appointments may be short lived if they are not isolated, identified and in some way given individual significance.






