DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The building is an attached corner building. It has three bays on the Mulberry Street side, and ~~four~~ ⁶ bays ^(5 bays on the 4th floor) on the Park Avenue side. It is four stories tall. The walls and ~~water table~~ are ~~made~~ of running bond brick.

The main entrance is on the corner of Mulberry Street and Park Avenue. It is a storefront. There is one step leading up to the door and stoop.

On the first floor there is one large picture window ^(on Park Ave) and five one pane windows. All the sills on the first floor are wooden. The lintels of the picture window and two other windows on the first floor are flat and made of wood. The other first floor windows have flat arched lintels and these are made of brick. The windows on the second floor have a two over four pane arrangement, wood sills, and flat arched brick lintels. The pane arrangement of the windows on the third and fourth stories is two over two. The lintels are flat arched and made of brick and the sills are made of wood.

There are two ~~side~~ entrances to the building. One is on Park Avenue and the other is on Mulberry Street.

The building is a story taller than those surrounding it, but is approximately the same width as the rest. The sixth bay on the Park Avenue side of the building is only three stories tall.

There is a slate shingled overhang over most of the first story. The cornice is supported by a corbel table and has very elaborate brackets. There is a bay window on the second story of the Park Avenue side of the building. It is composed of three windows that have a two over two pane arrangement. The third and fourth story windows on the Park Avenue side of the building have a four over four pane arrangement. The lintels and sills are the same as on the Mulberry street side. Also on the Park avenue side of the building there is a large iron firescape.


