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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The first of this 4 story, 2 bay rowhouse of painted running bond brick has been altered into a shopfront.

The first floor facade is devided into 3 vertical portions by wood pilasters. The portion to the left contains a wood door with 6 small square panes of glass in its top section, capped by a plain transom. The center portion contains the shop entrance and the right portion consists of a large one-over-one window over a wood panel. The shop is capped by a wood shingled pent roof which has been cut out so as not to obscure the lower part of the second floor windows.

The windows on the second floor are extremely tall 6-over-9 windows. Their sills are hedden by the applied roof, but their lintels are ornamented by bracketed hoods.

The third floor windows are 6-over-6 with stone sills and similar hoods, The fourth floor windows are also six-over-six with stone sills, but they have plain wood lintels. The cornice obscures a flat roof and is decorated by dentils and modillions.


