DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building is a 3 story 2 bay rowhouse of running bond brickwork. It shares a salleyport with 225 W. Mulberry. The slightly protruding right angled shopwindow has been boarded up, it now displays a logo and 2 signs. The entrance door of wood and glass is located to the right and topped by a transom. The glass is painted over. The shopfront is capped by a bracketed cornice. The brickwork of the upper floors is painted with striped joints. The two window bays are shifted towards the right. The two-over-two windows have stone sills and splayed brick lintels. The lower part of the cornice has been replaced by a strip of sheet metal, above several simple moldings remain to mark the edge of the flat roof.





