STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This building occupies the northeast corner of Park and Saratoga. It is seven stories high, three bays wide on the south side, and five bays wide on the east side. The first floor is faced with granite; upper floors are laid in common bond.

On the east side of the building, the first floor contains four large two-piece sheet glass windows which are set in flat-arched recesses. Above these windows is a stone bell course studded with six cartouches.

In the upper stories, windows are double casements in pairs. All have one piece underlights, and all are set in flat-arched recesses with splayed masonry lintels and straight bond sills (excepting the second story windows, where the bell course below forms the sills).

In the sixth story level there are two cartouches, the first of which is located between the first and second bays, the second between the fourth and fifth bays. There is a moulded bell course above this.

Flat masonry pilasters appear in pairs at either end of the building, and between the first and second and fourth and fifth bays. These pilasters support the entablature and dentiled cornice, the latter containing four cartouches.

The South side of the building is three bays wide. On the first floor are, from left to right, a small glass door; the main entrance, consisting of double glass doors with a one piece sheet glass transom; and a small square sheet glass window.

The arrangement of the upper stories is similar to the east side of the building.


