DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

No. 321 Park Avenue (lot #4) has been extensively modified from its original form, with the first floor built out almost four inches in modern brick. Into this face is set a large glass storefront window, surmounted by a two-foot chrome lintel bearing the legend "Arts and Crafts Supply Co." A large picture window has been cut into the second floor; it presently contains three large panes. The third and fourth stories (or third story and attic) each have three windows with stone sills and flat lintels. The material of the second through top stories is brick, set in running bond, and spray-painted beige, as was the wide stone cornice which hides the chimney from view. A line of four holes runs down the center of the facade, two under the attic story, one under the third story, and one under the second. Vertical ghost-marks on either side of the holes suggest that some sort of a rod or plank (perhaps supporting a commercial sign) once was attached to the house.
