DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This flat-roofed rowhouse, located near the corner of St. Paul Place and E. Franklin St., is three stories high and three bays wide. Surfaced originally in running-bond brick, the ground floor has been altered for commercial purposes.

A recessment, approached by a single stone step and approximately five feet deep, opens from the ground floor center bay to house three doors. At the back of the recessment are two rectangular doors with double transom; a thick wooden mullion separates the doors. On the left side of the recessment (421 St. Paul Place) is a centered door with flat transom flanked by thin side lights. On the right (419 St. Paul Place) is a double-light picture window. Both sides have boarded transoms at the level of the upper transoms of the back doors. The right and left ground floor bays are filled with two light picture windows under four-part transoms. A marble foundation underlies the windows.

Second and third story fenestration features a set of coupled rectangular windows (double-hung with 1/1 lights) in each bay; the couples are separated by fluted stone Doric pilasters and framed by stone sills and flat-arched brick lintels.

The raised brick course, frieze and bracketed wooden cornice are continued from 423-5 St. Paul Place.


