DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This flat-roofed rowhouse, located on the SE corner of Calvert and Bath streets, is three stories high and three bays wide. It is surfaced in running-bond brick, and the first floor has been altered for commercial purposes.</p> <p>A recessed rectangular door with flat transom opens from the center bay; it is approached by a single stone step. On either side within the recessment is a single light picture window with wood sill and foundation. Similar fenestration is found in the left and right bays. A narrow rectangular door with flat transom opens from the far right, also approached by a single stone step. A bracketed, projecting wooden storefront cornice separates the first and second stories.</p> <p>Each second story bay contains an elongated double-hung (6/9 lights) window with flat-arched brick lintel and wooden sill. Proportionately scaled third floor fenestration features double-hung (6/6 lights) windows. (with similar sills and lintels)</p> <p>A dentilled wooden cornice tops the structure.</p>


