DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The new Mercy Hospital Chapel is partially hidden by a beige common bond brick wall **ended in brown** marble. Composed of 2 large triangles joined by a rectangle and laid in common bond brick, The structure accomodates large stained glass windows which flood the interior.

The facade of the east triangle carries a large recessed open triangle. A high contemporary stained glass window in 12 sections **dominates** its right side. A smaller stained glass window occupies the lower left wall of the east wall, from which extends a minor brick triangle.

The 2nd, triangle, fronting on St. Paul Place, rises up into a rectangle. **A high narrow stained** glass window in the east facade sheds light into the connecting walkway between each section.

The north facade continues the relationship between light and composition, through the use of a q-sectioned stained glass window.

The Chapel is connected to the hospital by means of a metal and glass walkway.




Sanborn Map 1914, revised 1953
