DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This primarily solid, concrete and brick building was built in 1923 by Southern Supplies. Its facade was severely altered during the 1960's to accommodate banking facilities.</p> <p>The "pre-alteration" facade represents an architectural style very popular during the 1920's. Each floor is accented by symmetrical white diamond tiles, and as is typical of the style, a parapet rises above the roofline. Slight projections extend beyond the wall line, dividing the Calvert St. facade into 3 bays.</p> <p>A stone foundation holds two basement windows, protected by iron grills, of five, fixed lights. Four stone steps lead to the recessed entrance with double, metal doors, each mounted by 1/1 diamond, fixed lights. On either side of the entrance are 2 large areas, originally windows, that are infilled with stone.</p> <p>The upper stories are punctuated by symmetrical fenestration. The 3 fixed windows on each floor are grouped in fours, each section having 4/4/4/4 lights.</p> <p>Rising above the roofline, and accenting the parapet, are moderately inclining bands of white tile. The lower band, separated by a single, diamond tile, is inscribed with "Southern Supplies - 1923." A smaller band borders the upper perimeter of the parapet and is continued across the bays. The brick projections are ornamented by geometric tile designs.</p>




