DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The building is three bays wide and three stories high with a flat roof and brick foundation and building wall. Second and third story facade fenestration is symmetrical. The first story facade is a storefront articulated with centered, flat double doors surmounted by a flat single light transom. The two elements are housed in a recessed entrance. Flat store windows surmounted by flat transoms flank the entrance to either side.

The 2nd and 3rd story facades are each punctuated by three flat double hung windows with two over two lights. Sills and lintles are of brick. Basketweave brickwork surmounts the 3rd story facade windows. The cornice is of decorative bricks. There is decorative brickwork throughout the facade. The roof is flat.

This building dates c. 1860 and has been used as a shop since then. Although not representative as an example of any particular architectural style, the building is significant architecturally as a successful combination of various stylistic elements added.

The ornate brickwork is unusual for a building of this date and scale.






Sanborn Map 1914, revised 1953


