DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The first floor of this four story painted brick building has been remodeled and is faced with concrete. There are three large two paned shop windows whose bottom sills step up with the slope of the street. There is a dark grey polished stone base board which step up the slope under the window sills.

The three bays of the upper floors are separated by pilasters, and are fully arched at the fourth floor. The one-over-one windows are arranged in recessed three sided bays on the second and third floors. Metal panels ornamented with swags separate them horizontally. The windows set within the arches feature a central one-over-one panel topped by a transom and flanked by fixed sidelights which conform to the curve of the arch. The crown of each arch is ornamented by a scrolled bracket with swag. Two circular medallions between the three arches are inscribed with the date (18 on the left, 96 on the right). The cornice has modillions and dentils. Its frieze features swags in relief as well as three small circular windows over each bay.

Although the ground floor facade has been altered, this building, dating c. 1910, is a representative though by no means striking, example of two styles, Sullivanesque and Commercial, well integrated into a single design. Historically significant as prototypical of this stylistic combination.




