DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building is three stories high and eight bays wide, and is laid in common bond. The first story has been extensively altered. On the left of the facade, wooden siding pierced by rectangular sheet glass windows flanks a recessed entrance. The store front on the right is older. Beneath a moulded cornice, two sheet glass windows flank two recessed doors, between which is another sheet glass window. In between the two store fronts is a paneled door with a Federal-style frame and pediment.

All windows are double hung with six-over-six lights, stone sills, and segmental arched, keystone, straight bond lintels. In the second and seventh bays of the second story are two wooden doors with nine lights and tripartite transoms, also set in segmental arches.

A string course of brick appears above the third story. A corbeled, projecting roof cornice is of brick and wood.
